CHICAGO NPO STARTUP, BENEVOLENT.NET, SURPASSES \$10K IN ONLINE DONATIONS

<u>Benevolent.net</u> passed a milestone in contributions from supporters this past week by raising more than \$10,000 through a new online platform that seeks to empower individuals to donate directly to help lowincome adults overcome a hurdle or challenge. Launched on December 1st, 2011, Benevolent's unique and secure giving model allows donors to contribute to directly meet needs not met by traditional social services; meeting these needs will help low-income adults move forward toward their goals. *See Emily's success story below.*

This startup was conceived of and launched by Chicago-area leader Megan Kashner. The mission of Benevolent is to bring dignity and self-determination to both sides of the giving equation, illuminating the realities of life on the edge of sustainability.

Success Story – Emily

Emily was in an abusive relationship and needed to move as quickly as possible with her 4 children to a safe and secret location. As the date for the security deposit drew nearer, word went out via Benevolent's website and social media channels, and within 24 hours Emily's need went from less than half-funded to fully-funded.
